

Digital pictures to film

WWW.3DWORLDSHOP.COM has its own film recorder. The Polaroid 8000 is one of the best film recorders ever made. The machine offers a maximum resolution of 8192 x 5464 pixels. Digital images can be transferred by us to 35 mm film; slides or negative. Slides or negative film is developed by us and sent to you in cut slides or in longer strips. We do not mount slides! If you prefer we can also send you a non-developed film with you pictures on it. We only use Kodak film. We need about 10 days to convert your digital files to film. This is not with postage time included. We can not be held responsible for pictures that arrive to late to your liking.

PRICES (including film and developing, but without VAT andd postage charge)

**3,50 euro for every first recording of a digital image
2,50 euro for every extra recording of one and the same image**

**Starting costs for film and developing: 15 euro
No starting costs will be payed when you send 25 or more images.**

NOTE. A 3D slide consist of TWO separate digital files.

SENDING IMAGES

You can send us your digital files on cdrom, or on USB-stick. Also email is possible, but please use a service like www.yousendit.com. Your files are too large for our personal email box. Make sure your pictures are set to RGB colors, so not CMYK. All files will be recorderd to film in the dimensions 3:2. If you files are measured otherwise, we will have to record them with a black band in order to have the full picture recorded.



Pixels and DPI

Please send us digital files with a maximum number of pixels, offcourse without enlarging the original image. Minimum pixel requirement for a decent result is 1800 x 1200 pixels. For the film recorder, only the pixels count; not the DPI (dots per inch). You will see no differences in quality between for example 72 dpi or 300 dpi, as long as the pixel dimensions (for example 1800 x 1200) are the same.

The orientation of your pictures can be Portrait or Landscape. A portrait picture we will record on film, lying down; in order to have it fill the frame. We try to have pictures fill the frame, without ever cropping it. If you prefer it otherwise, let us know.
